




THEN THERE WAS AN IDEA...






THEN THERE WAS AN IDEA...











THAT'S THE STORY OF WORK!






WORKER VALUE ILLUMINATED...

- A worker is as valuable as s/he provides solutions (works).
- A worker is more valuable, the more solutions/work s/he provides.
- A worker is less valuable, the more problems (work) s/he causes.
- It is a gradient scale of value and a mix of solutions and problems.
- No worker is perfectly valuable.
- No worker is perfectly problematic.
- There are some lines a worker should not cross, though.

GRADIENT SCALE OF WORKER VALUE




